What is the licence?

Your organisation can apply for an annual licence for cases taught to undergraduate students.

What cases are included?

Enjoy access to over 35,000 cases from a diverse group of leading business schools. Cases are available on all aspects of national and international business and management.

How much does the licence cost?

The annual licence fee is between £2,000 (€2,500, \$2,700) and £8,000 (€10,000, \$10,800) depending on your whole organisation's annual income.

How are cases accessed?

Once your licence has been paid for, all staff at your organisation can access cases for use on undergraduate programmes via The Case Centre's website.
